Sub:- Delivery of CMR to FCI for KMS 2014-15.

Ref:- Govt. in FS & CW Department letter No. 17615 dt.02.09.2015.

Sir,

Inviting a reference to the letter on the subject cited above, I am to say that against 15,46,485 M.T CMR due for delivery at FCI depot as per district-wise delivery percentage fixed by Govt. for KMS 2014-15, 12,55,298 M.T CMR has been delivered to FCI leaving a balance of 2,91,187 M.T as on 14.09.2015.

2. Besides 4,02,983 M.T CMR is still to be received from custom millers at RRCs as on 14.09.2015 against procurement of 33,75,482 M.T CMR during KMS 2014-15 and 4,23,156 M.T CMR is available in godowns as on 31.08.2015 for utilization.
3. OSCSC can utilize 8,75,942 M.T CMR during the allotment month from September, 2015 to January, 2016 as per district wise requirement of rice under PDS. Receipt of further CMR at RRCs beyond the requirement may result in deterioration of quality of rice due to long storage.
4. If balance 2,91,187 M.T CMR is not delivered at FCI depot, there will be a surplus of 2,41,384 M.T CMR with OSCSC Ltd. during February, 2016.
5. Due to lack of storage space in RRCs of most of the high procuring districts, receipt of rice from millers has been hampered a lot. If rice due to be delivered to FCI is received at RRCs after relaxation in delivery percentage in some districts, the pace of delivery will be further slowed down which may result in misappropriation of stock of OSCSC by the miller. Rather delivery of more CMR to FCI at the fixed percentage will be beneficial to OSCSC Ltd.

In view of above, it is requested that relaxation in delivery percentage of CMR to FCI may not be considered at present and custom millers may continue to deliver CMR at FCI depots to complete their quota by the end of 31.10.2015 i.e. the delivery period fixed by Govt. of India for KMS 2014-15.
