Sub: Percentage of FCI delivery during KMS 2015-16 (Kharif) from OSCSC account.

Madam/Sir,

I am directed to say that paddy procurement for Kharif Season under KMS 2015-16 has started in several districts and delivery of resultant rice is expected very soon. As there is shortage of storage space with OSCSC and need to deliver surplus rice to FCI, it has been decided that the percentage of delivery of rice to FCI will be regulated as hereunder:-

Category of District	Cut of date for calculating miller eligibility	Percentage of delivery to FCI with reference to total delivery
1 st phase districts	30 th November, 2015	100% during December, 2015 and January, 2016 80% February/ March, 2016
2 nd phase districts	31 st December, 2015	100% for January/ February, 2016 80% for March and April, 2016

It may be noted that district wise FCI delivery percentage will be allocated later after analysing the progress of procurement and estimated surplus in the district and State. This may be brought to the notice of all concerned. Mill is the unit for delivery of rice and not the district.
