Delivery of CMR due by the Millers for the KMS-2015-16 by 30-09-16
difficulties of storage capacity thereof.

Sir,

In inviting a reference to the subject cited above, I am to intimate you that during KMS-2015-16 a stock of Q.1313727.17 of paddy has been procured from this District of which CMR due comes to Q.893334.48. As per stipulation fixed by the Govt. 20% of CMR due will be delivered to FCI which comes to Q.178667.00 and the balance stock of Q.714667.48 will be received at RRC-cum-DSC.

Further, One Custom Miller M/S S. R. Agro has lifted Q.29276.49 paddy from Keonjhar District. The CMR due against said paddy comes to Q.19908.02. Out of which Q.3982.00 (20%) will be delivered to FCI and balance stock of Q.15926.02 will be delivered at RRC-cum-DSCs in Sundargarh District.

As such the total quantity of CMR to be received at RRC-cum-DSC of Sundargarh District comes to Q.730593.90 for consumption under PDS.

There are 13 nos. of RRC-cum-DSCs in Sundargarh District having total godown capacity of Q.69500.00 only (for storage of both Rice & Wheat) and the monthly requirement of rice under NFSA is around Q.60000.00. More over maximum number of godown (RRC-cum-DSC) are of small in size which have been rationalized keeping in view the accommodation of stock (Rice/Wheat) of allotment of particular area (Block/UI.B). Further monthly allotment of Wheat is Q.21448.82

There is no other godowns like PEG/OSWC/CWC in this district. So to receive the entire CMR due within the KMS 2015-16 i.e. by September 2016 from the Custom Miller is not possible in existing RRC-cum-DSC, unless & until the adequate storage capacity is arranged/explored.



As on 31-05-2016 only a stock of Q.157599.96 has been received from millers leaving a balance stock of Q.572993.94 to be received within the 4 months i.e. by end of Sept'-2016. Accordingly the average quantity to be received in a month at RRC-cum-DSC comes to Q.143248.50 which is more than two times of total godown capacity.

So, it is not at all possible to receive the balance CMR from Millers within the stipulated time i.e. 30-09-2016 during KMS-2015-16.


It is therefore requested to make alternative suitable arrangement for delivery of balance CMR so as to enable to complete the delivery within the KMS i.e. KMS-2015-16.
