Proceedings of the Weekly Paddy Procurement Review Meeting held on 23.06.2016 at 5.30 pm in the Conference Hall of OSCSC Ltd.

The weekly paddy procurement review meeting was held under the Chairmanship of Principal Secretary, FS&CW Department on 23.06.2016 at 5.30 P.M in the Conference Hall of OSCSC Ltd. The list of members/ their representatives present in the meeting is annexed.

Principal Secretary to Govt., FS&CW Department reviewed paddy procurement for KMS 2015-16 and the following picture emerged.

In Kharif season **41.69 lakh MT** paddy was procured which is **4%** higher than procurement compared to previous Kharif.

In Rabi season, currently ongoing, **8.71 Lakh MT** of paddy has been procured. *Target for Rabi fixed by Cabinet is 7 Lakh MT in terms of rice i.e. around 10 Lakh MT in terms of paddy.* Last Rabi we procured **12.28 Lakh MT** of paddy. A total of 20 districts are participating in Rabi. All agencies were requested to complete Rabi procurement by 30.06.2016 positively. P-PAS module would be closed on the evening of 30.06.2016.

CMR delivered is **18,51,299** MT. State average of delivery of CMR is **54%**, all agencies included. For OSCSC alone, it is **52%**. For *Bhadrak, Jagatsinghpur, Keonjhar, Nayagarh and Sundargarh* delivery is less than 40%. *Collectors of these districts need to gear up CMR delivery.*

The following decisions were taken in the meeting.

Delivery of CMR:

Stoppage of delivery to FCI in Khordha and others

- Delivery of CMR by OSCSC to FCI will be stopped in the following districts. Reasons:- There would be no surplus rice available in these districts considering their own requirement vis-a-vis procurement. Further existing stocks with FCI will be sufficient to meet the requirement of food grains under Other Welfare Schemes in those districts.

Delivery to RRCs instead of FCI by other State Agencies

- State agencies like TDCC and MARKFED will deliver the remaining stocks at RRCs in Rayagada and Nabarangpur districts.

Reasons:- These are deficit districts. Evacuating CMR from those districts through FCI and again inducting through internal road movement is a needless exercise which needs to be dispensed with.

- Delivery of raw rice to FCI by OSCSC will be stopped at Kalahandi, Bolangir and Sonepur.

Reason:- The requirement of Raw rice of Nabarangpur, Malkangiri and Rayagada will be met by the above districts.

Facilitating delivery of CMR at Nayagarh

- Considering the space problem at Nayagarh, it is decided that 4000 MT of CMR will be moved immediately to Kandhamal.

Reason:-Nayagarh would be surplus even after its own consumption and the nearby deficit districts delivery of surplus CMR to FCI should be expedited.

- Surplus rice of Boudh may be transferred to Kandhamal considering availability of space at Kandhamal.

Movement of CMR from Bhadrak

- To expedite delivery of CMR at Bhadrak and considering the fact of vacant space available at Jagatsinghpur, immediate movement of CMR to Jagatsinghpur may be commenced.

100% utilization of RRCs

- All the RRCs should be utilized 100% as sufficient vacant space is available which can facilitate delivery of CMR.

Receipt of CMR in Sundergarh

- Considering the remaining rice to be received at Sundergarh and the space available, it may not be possible to complete delivery within stipulated deadline. OSCSC Ltd. may look into the possibility of hiring the FCI godown at Jharsuguda.

Hiring of godowns in certain districts to facilitate receipt of CMR

- Considering the severe space crunch in Keonjhar district, it is decided to hire the godown of 5000 MTC of FCI at Barbil by OSCSC immediately.
- OSCSC will explore the need for hiring godowns at Bhadrak , Balasore, Mayurbhanj, Keonjhar, Sundargarh, Jajpur, Dhenkanal, Cuttack, Koraput, Ganjam, Puri and Nayagarh.

Stoppage of delivery of rice to RRCs at Baragarh etc.

- Delivery of rice at RRCs should immediately be stopped at Baragarh, Sambalpur and Kalahandi. However, in Kalahandi only raw rice will continue be received at RRCs.
- Low delivery districts would achieve 60% of CMR delivery by end of June failing which CSOs will be held personally liable.

Maintenance of Accounts:

- Districts shall maintain separate accounts of Kharif and Rabi Paddy as advised to them by OSCSC. A letter may go from FS&CW Department.

E-Governance:

- CSM Technologies Ltd may develop a software to manage movement of CMR using least cost transportation method. MD, OSCSC will guide CSM Technologies for the project.

Economy in OSCSC:

- All operations connected with procurement by OSCSC must be based on prudence and least cost methods so that economy becomes the spin-off in all activities. Every penny of the premier State PSU needs to be saved.















Millers' Issues:
