





5. If the reason for delayed milling is lack of sufficient milling capacity in the State, then following details should be filled in;
- Total Milling Capacity available (per day) in the State.
  - Average quantity of paddy milled per day in the season in the State.
  - Details of tangible efforts made by the State Govt. to improve milling capacity of paddy in the State.
  - Quantity of paddy proposed to be milled per day, if extension is granted.

6. In case the reasons for delay in delivery are other than storage capacity and lack of milling capacity, such as quality issues, lack of sufficient staff etc. then the details should be provided hereunder:
1. Procurement started from mid-November in Western Odisha and from mid-December to early January 2017 in Coastal Odisha. This caused delay.
  2. Lack of adequate storage space has resulted in late receipt of CMR from the Custom Millers.
  3. Limitation in receipt by FCI and evacuation of surplus CMR due to very few rake points in surplus western districts.



9 Detailed comments and recommendations of FCI, GM, Region.

*By FCI Working*

- i) The balance surplus CMR of 0.08 LMT of KMS 2016-17 (Kharif Crop) is yet to be received by 31.08.2017.
- ii) Further a quantity of 1.3 LMT surplus CMR of KMS 2016-17 (Rabi Crop) is also expected to be received by 30.09.2017 (FCI)
- iii) For avoiding operational difficulties extension of time period up to 31.10.2017 for receiving CMR of KMS 2016-17 (Kharif Crop) under DCP may be considered due to lack of storage space & milling capacity in some part of the State.
