

MINUTES OF THE MEETING ON REVIEW OF PROCRUMENT RELATED ISSUES
HELD ON 16.11.2017 AT 3.00 PM

The meeting was held in OSCSC Board Room.

Commissioner-cum-Secretary to Govt., FS & CW Department was in the Chair

The list of members present is enclosed at **Annexure**.

Initiating discussion, the Managing Director, OSCSC apprised the storage gap in 30 districts taking into consideration requirement of PDS commodities, existing godowns and upcoming godowns in the State.

M.D. also apprised that 144 millers of 18 districts have not yet delivered 52568 M.T CMR till 15.11.2017 and 92 millers have misappropriated Rs. 134 Cr. from KMS 2003-04 to 2015-16.

The General Manager(Procurement), OSCSC submitted in detail the district wise miller(s) who have not yet delivered rice for KMS 2016-17 and status of defaulting millers of earlier KMS.

After threadbare discussions the following decisions were taken :

DELIVERY OF CMR FOR KMS 2016-17

- The CSO-cum-District Managers of 18 districts concerned shall be pursued to expedite delivery of balance CMR of KMS 2016-17 by the millers within the stipulated period i.e. 30.11.2017. No further extension for delivery of CMR shall be allowed.
- The millers who complete 100% delivery after cut-off date shall not be allowed to participate in procurement operations without the clearance of OSCSC Head Office/FS & CW Department. If required, millers of other districts would be inducted for smooth procurement operations.

PROSECUTION AGAINST DEFAULTING MILLERS

- There are 34 misappropriation cases involving **Rs. one crore** and more covering KMS 2010-11 to 2015-16. Those cases are to be handed over to EOW.
- OSCSC, in order to expedite collection of required documents and papers from the concerned districts, shall form 4 teams who would be deputed to the districts assigned to them and complete the preliminary work by 31.12.2017 required for filing of FIR.

- C.A Audit shall be completed in case of remaining 12 defaulting millers on or before 31.12.2017.

STORAGE ISSUE

- 32 nos. of storage godowns of 2500 M.T. capacity each at 32 project locations shall be taken up under Odisha PEG-2013 (Phase-III) scheme and OSCSC to take necessary steps for floating of RFP under intimation to P& C Department.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair and the participants.
