Ref:- This office letter No.20232 dt. 02.11.2012 –Operational Guidelines for KMS- 12-13.

Sir,

With reference to the subject & letter cited above, I am to say that there is some confusion on implementation of the provision in operational guideline for KMS 2012-13 regarding imposition of holding charges on the custom millers for delay in delivery of CMR to OSCSC. It is learnt that some districts have imposed holding charges on the millers in variance to the guideline issued for KMS 2012-13. In this connection, I am to clarify the provision in para No.45.2 in the procurement guideline as follows.

- i. For calculation of holding charges the period 120 days shall be from the date of issue of paddy from joint custody & maintenance for milling to actual date of delivery of CMR at RRC/FCI
- ii. Designated rice receiving centres means, where the custom millers have been asked to deliver CMR either at RRC or FCI as authorized in the Delivery Certificate or subsequently modified by CSO-cum-DM in writing.
