Sub: Utilisation of balance CMR of the KMS 2012-13 before delivery of CMR for the KMS 2013-14 to the Rice Receiving Centres of OSCSC.

Madam/ Sir,

Inviting a reference to the above subject, I am to say that as on date (19-12-13), the OSCSC Ltd. is yet to receive **5.32 Lakh MT** CMR on the paddy procured during KMS2012-13. In addition to the above stock which is to be received from the millers, the RRCs of OSCSC have about **3.80 Lakh MT** CMR (of KMS 2012-13) in stock at various locations.

1. In eight surplus procuring districts of Bargarh, Bhadrak, Jagatsinghpur, Jharsuguda, Kalahandi, Nayagarh, Sambalpur & Subarnapur, there is a stock of 3.20 Lakh MT CMR in the RRCs and about 3 Lakh MT of CMR is yet to be received from the millers.
2. Unless stocks from these districts are evacuated, they are unable to realise the balance CMR of KMS 2012-13 from the custom millers and are also experiencing difficulties in procuring paddy for the current KMS 2013-14. Besides long storage of stock will deteriorate the quality of the rice. In view of these problems, there is a need to treat the entire State as one unit.
3. It is also seen that millers of single crop districts are reluctant to deliver CMR to FCI towards the fag end of the KMS due to slight discolouration caused by long storage of paddy.
4. In order to obviate the problems mentioned above, **It is decided that CMR for the KMS 2013-14 in boiled rice procuring districts shall not be received at RRC till 31st March'14.** Till that date, all deliveries for CMR of KMS 2013-14 will be delivered to FCI depots. The CSO-cum-D.M. shall issue Delivery Certificate only for delivery of CMR to Food Corporation of India during the above period. But CMR due for KMS 2012-13 shall continue to be received in RRC as per the existing instructions. The raw rice producing mills in these Districts shall continue to deliver rice to FCI depots as per existing instructions.
5. In case of **raw consuming and producing district**, CMR for the KMS 2013-14 shall be received as usual at RRC & FCI as per the norms communicated by the Odisha State Civil Supplies Corporation, as there is no surplus raw rice in any district for inter district movement.

6. Requirement of monthly PDS allotment till March'14 in boiled rice consuming districts will be met out of the CMR procured during the KMS 2012-13 inside the district as well as on transportation from other districts. Transportation programme will be made by the Corporation to meet the requirement of each district basing on the availability of own procured CMR. **Under no circumstance the CMR procured for the KMS 2013-14 shall be received at RRC till the month of March'14 except in raw consuming districts.**
7. Basing on this arrangement, it has been programmed to transport following quantity of CMR from the surplus procuring districts during the month of January'14 to March'14.
