Sub: Percentage of delivery by Millers Agent to FCI during KMS 2014-15.

Madam/Sir,

In inviting a reference to above cited letter, I am to say that process of farmer's registration(FR) is yet to be completed and complete picture of marketable surplus yet to be assessed FR is expected to be completed by 25th February'15.. Since PDS consumption of your Districts are high, relaxation on percentage of CMR delivery to FCI for KMS 2014-15 is considered on following terms.

1. All Rice Millers participating in KMS 2014-15 will deliver 25% of CMR to FCI till May, 2015 and rest 75% of CMR will be delivered to RRCs subject to condition at (2). The CSO-cum- District Managers may issue DCs for FCI Depots & RRCs.
2. If any Miller who had FCI backlog for last KMS has completed the backlog delivery to FCI will be allowed to deliver 25% of CMR of KMS 2014-15 to FCI and rest 75% to RRCs.

This is applicable to Millers of only Malkangiri, Ganjam, Gajapati, Puri, Kendrapada, Jagatsinghpur, Keonjhar, Mayurbhanja, Anugul, Dhenkanal & Sundargarh Districts only.

This may be brought to the notice of all concerned.
