Sub: **Relaxation in security norms of Custom miller during the KMS 2014-15**

Ref. This Deptt. letter No.18902 dt.21.11.2014 and No.19726 dt.02.12.2014

Sir,

With reference to the letters and subject cited above, I am to say that reports have been received that millers are unable to lift paddy from paddy purchase centres in view of tight security deposit norms. Consequently paddy is lying in the purchase centres leading to dislocation in procurement process.

In order to obviate the above situation, it has been decided that millers of your districts who have shown good performance in last two to three years and delivered 100% CMR by 30.11.2014 for KMS 2013-14 can be allowed 10% security. Consequently, they can lift 10 times paddy of security deposit.

You are therefore requested to ensure lifting of paddy from PPCs by millers in order to avoid any disruption in the procurement process. Further, delivery of CMR by the millers may be closely monitored
