Subject: Filling of 40 kg paddy in 50 kg capacity bags-reg.


Sir,

I am directed to refer to a FCI's communication No. Proc.III/3(1)/2010-11/Vol II/615 dated March 17, 2015 in which it has been stated that decision of Government of India in respect of filling of 40 kg paddy in the SBT bag of 50 kg capacity is still awaited except in case of Punjab.

2. As already intimated, a field check for filling of paddy in 50 kg capacity bag has already been conducted by JS (P&FCI) and FCI. As per that, the GOI has permitted minimum filling of 37.5 kg of paddy in one bag of 50 kg capacity. Further, due to variation in grain size, quality and various factors, weight of filled paddy in one bag of 50 kg may vary from place to place/State to State.

3. In view of the above facts, it has been decided that each State Agency will have to ensure minimum filling of 37.5 kg of paddy in each 50 kg capacity bag. However, the cost of the bags to be reimbursed by this Department will be restricted, subject to actual consumption of bags in case of those States, where as per prevailing practice more paddy is being filled in the bags of 50 Kg. capacity.
