Sub: Procurement of paddy by FCI in Sambalpur district during KMS
2012-13 (Rabi)

Sir,

I am directed to invite reference to your letter No.871 dt.25.05.2013 on the subject mentioned above and to say that with increase in target of procurement from 30 lakh MT to 40 lakh MT in terms of rice in the KMS 2012-13, the quantum of surplus rice has also increased substantially. It will increase the outward movement from the State to the tune of 16 lakh MT resulting more concentration of FCI towards movement operations. The FCI has only 5.93 lakh MT storage space for foodgrain operations which is quite insufficient for rice as well as paddy procurement. The FCI is also running with less number of staff to handle rice as well as paddy procurement operation. Since FCI has to concentrate on evacuation of surplus rice to outside the State, the target meant for FCI for procurement shall be looked into by OSCSC Ltd.

You are therefore requested not to insist FCI for paddy procurement in Rabi Season in Sambalpur district.
