Proceedings of the Weekly Paddy Procurement Review Meeting held on 07.06.2016 at 5.00 pm in the Conference Hall of OSDMA

The weekly paddy procurement review meeting was held under the Chairmanship of Principal Secretary, FS&CW Department on 07.06.2016 at 5.00 P.M in the Conference Hall of OSDMA. The list of members/ their representatives present in the meeting is annexed.

Principal Secretary to Govt., FS&CW Department reviewed paddy procurement for KMS 2015-16 and the following picture emerged.

In Kharif season **41.69 lakh MT** paddy was procured which is **4%** higher than procurement compared to previous Kharif.

In Rabi season, currently ongoing, 6,08,123 MT of paddy has been procured. Target for Rabi is 7 Lakh MT in terms of rice i.e. around 10 Lakh MT in terms of paddy. Last Rabi we procured 12.28 Lakh MT of paddy.

A total of 20 districts are participating in Rabi; OSCSC in all 20 districts; MARKFED in 6; TDCC in 4 and NACOF in 4. Rabi procurement has started in 10 districts. Other districts should immediately commence procurement; among agencies, OSCSC, MARKFED, TDCC and NACOF have started procurement. All agencies were requested to complete Rabi procurement by 30.06.2016 positively. P-PAS module would be closed on the evening of 30.06.2016.

CMR delivered is 16,56,692 MT. **State average** of delivery of CMR is **51%**, all agencies included. For OSCSC alone, it is **49%**. For *Bhadrak* and *Jagatsinghpur* delivery is less than *30%*. *Collectors of these districts* need to gear up CMR delivery.

During June so far, FCI has evacuated 42,300 MT of CMR from Odisha. The Principal Secretary made the decisions and observations as follow:

Closure of procurement operations for KMS 2015-16 on time:

 No extension beyond 30.09.2016 shall be sought from Gol for delivery of CMR. It has therefore already been reiterated that delivery of CMR shall be completed by 15.09.2016.

Prudent movement and delivery plan:

- A committee under the Chairmanship of MD, OSCSC with GM, FCI, GM (Proc.), GM (PDS) and GM (Accounts) of OSCSC as members shall formulate a delivery and movement plan for CMR to bring in prudence in procurement/movement operations.
- Criss-cross movement of rice must stop.
- The surplus of a district, after meeting its own and neighbouring districts' needs, shall be delivered to FCI for evacuation.

Delivery of CMR and Evacuation by FCI:

- FCI, Odisha has evacuated 1.76 Lakh MT of CMR from the State in May'2016, which is a benchmark.
- MD, OSCSC proposed that in June, 2 Lakh MT of CMR would be delivered to FCI.
- FCI, Odisha would accordingly make its preparations. Where there is temporary requirement of Purchase Officer, GM may provide.

Performance of State Agencies:

 There are complaints in respect of State Agencies like MARKFED and NACOF. They need to furnish a report how they are financing and managing their procurement operations.

Utilization of PEG godowns:

 OSCSC is giving guaranteed rentals for PEG godowns subject to reimbursement by GoI. Optimal utilization of such godowns must be ensured to prevent future CAG paras.

Preparations for KMS 2016-17:

 Tagging of millers with societies shall be revisited. Prudence has to be built into the process. A module would be developed for the purpose.
 OMEGA would render the necessary assistance.

Millers' Issues:

 GM (Accounts) shall submit an updated status on distance certification given by districts and payment position in terms of such certification where districts have complied.

- Secretary, AORMA submitted that the new Custom Milling of Rice Order, 2016 is restrictive of free trade in rice/paddy. Principal Secretary observed that those who complete delivery can go for free trade as envisaged in the Order.
- MD, OSCSC may apprise on AORMA's requests for revision of T.C and incidentals.

Quality Control:

- Principal Secretary observed that compliance of Quality Control norms in RRCs is inadequate. There are complaints of poor quality of rice in RRCs in contrast to quality of rice being delivered to FCI. This dichotomy has to stop. A letter may go from the Department to all Collectors.
- Samples of rice collected during visit of Principal Secretary to Bhadrak on 06.06.2016 shall be analysed by Q.C Cell of FS&CW Department and FCI separately and, if required, jointly and report furnished. GM, FCI may instruct AGM (Q.C.) to render necessary assistance.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair and all participants.
