Sub: Security norms for defaulting Custom Miller after regularisation.

Ref: Your letter No.5765 dated 13/11/2018.

Sir,

The letter under reference relates to query on the norm of security to apply to the Millers in the ensuing KMS 2018-19, after regularisation of their act of commission/omission in earlier periods of KMS Default by Millers for the purpose of OSCSC Ltd. is explained as below:

- 1) Short fall of paddy detected by visiting squad
- 2) The Millers does not return the resultant CMR by the stipulated date.
- 3) There is defalcation of stock (both either paddy and rice)

As you have cited there are instances of defaulting Millers who have participated in KMS 2017-18 on 1:1 security deposit norm and confusion persists with regard to ratio between the security to be deposited and the value of paddy to be procured from 2018-19 onwards. Now it is clarified that the such Mills will be given the status of new units and provision of the guidelines as mentioned in para-21.2 relating to districts having deficit milling capacity will apply to all such cases of all the districts i.e. in the first year 1:1, in the second year 1:2 and 3rd year 1:3.
