In inviting reference on the subject cited above, I am to say that, after successful implementation of Paddy Procurement Automation System (P-PAS) in 10 high procuring Blocks of Baragarh, Bhadrak, Kalahandi, Koraput, Sambalpur and Sonepur districts during KMS 2013-14 the FS & CW Deptt. in principle has taken a decision to replicate P-PAS in 50 more Blocks covering 24 Districts of the state during kharif Marketing Season 2014-15. Under the System, on-line transactions of all operations up to payment to farmers will be automated for better monitoring and transparency.

 To make P-PAS successful, all the societies may be directed to complete online FIC registration process by September 2014 so that it will be integrated with the system before commencement of KMS 2014-15.

Please provide relevant information related to paddy procurement to the OMEGA Team for ensuring smooth implementation of the P-PAS in your District.
