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Sir/Madam,

Please refer to the letters cited above by which the decision of Government of India regarding adherence to the time limits for delivery of CMR and levy rice due to be handed over to FCI against the paddy procured for Central Pool in a Kharif Marketing Season has been communicated and it has been provided that no CMR / levy rice will be received by FCI after the cut off date, fixed by the Government of India, from the State agencies/ millers and undelivered quantities will be removed from the data of Central Pool procurement of paddy/rice maintained by the State Government concerned/ FCI.

2. In this context, it is further clarified that the timelines fixed by the Central Government in this regard will apply to Central Pool DCP operations also and State Governments concerned are requested to ensure compliance of these timelines, as any slippage in this regard badly affects the timely milling of paddy and delivery of CMR/ levy rice by the millers to State agencies or FCI, as the case may be, as well as delivery of surplus CMR in DCP States to FCI under Central Pool in next Kharif Marketing Season and it may also lead to malpractices.

3. FCI will monitor the situation in various DCP States in this regard and inform about any violations to the Central Government promptly.
