Against the total CMR due of 29.03 lakh MT, FCI has received 7.41 Lakh MT of CMR and OSCSC has received 2157679 MT making a total receipt of 2899312 MT. This leaves a balance of about 7447 MT of rice to be received from the Millers by OSCSC in following districts.

The defaulting Custom Millers are mainly from Bhadrak, Sonepur & Cuttack districts against whom action needs to be taken for recovery of the CMR.. The

Commissioner-cum-Secretary instructed the M.D.,OSCSC Ltd. to make analysis of the defaulting Custom Millers district wise and Miller wise. The M.D.OSCSC Ltd. informed that FIR had been lodged against Millers of Kalahandi & Subarnapur districts. Three Mills of Bhadrak district i.e Bharati Rice Mill, Krishna Rice Mill and S.N.Rice Mill are to deliver 2000 MT, 1100 MT and 270 MT of CMR respectively.

# 2. Review on Procurement of paddy and delivery of rice for KMS 2012-13

The review of procurement of paddy and delivery of rice by different Agencies for the KMS 2012-13 was made. On review it was found that 4578260 MT of paddy has been procured as on 28.5.2013

The following table shows the Agency wise procurement of paddy and delivery of rice as on 28.05.2013.

It is seen that paddy procured this year (till on date) is 41% more than that of last KMS and the CMR delivery is 44% higher than last KMS. But CMR due to be delivered as on date is more than 16 lakh MT and is likely to rise due to bumper Rabi harvest this year.

# Plan for delivery to FCI & Evacuation by FCI.

During review it was found that 505826 MT of CMR has been received by FCI till date in this KMS. The DGM ,FCI informed that utilisation of Storage space is around 88%. Nawarangpur district is delivering slowly to FCI.

D.G.M., informed that FCI will evacuate the planned 120,000 MT of CMR in May,2013. For June,13 they have got a target to evacuate1.2 LMT of Boiled Rice & 0.1 lakh MT of Raw rice ( Total 1.3 lakh MT) with no wheat induction.
