Sir,

With reference to the letter under reference, I am to inform you that the State of Odisha has suffered heavily due to incessant rainfall during 12th to 14th of June, 2013 and consequent floods. The affected districts are Kalahandi, Koraput, Rayagada, Nabarangpur and other neighboring district in the southern part of the State.

The following relaxation in norms of Paddy and Rice may be considered so as to mitigate the hardship of the farmers, without value-cut.

Paddy:

The damaged, discoloured, sprouted and weevilled refraction may be relaxed upto 6% as against 4% in the uniform specification.

Rice_:
