Sub: **Delivery of CMR to FCI for the KMS 2014-15 from OSCSC Ltd. account.**

Madam/Sir,

In supersession of this Department letter No.21160 dt.23.12.2014 and letter No.3239 dt.11.02.2015 on the subject mentioned above, I am to say that the OSCSC Ltd. has been procuring surplus CMR under DCP scheme in comparison to the annual requirement under Public Distribution System and Other Welfare Schemes. The surplus CMR is required to be delivered to FCI from OSCSC Ltd. account like previous years in order to utilize the storage space of FSDs available in all districts, evacuate the surplus CMR from the State and to receive the CMR due from the millers in the limited godown space available with OSCSC Ltd.

The districts having surplus and deficit procurement have been identified basing on their annual requirement under PDS and OWS and availability of backlog rice dues of KMS 2013-14. Keeping this in view, the Government has decided for delivery of CMR by 29 districts (except Kandhamal) to FCI in the current KMS 2014-15 as per the target fixed below.
