Sub: Settlement of Bills of millers for KMS 2011-12.

We draw your kind attention to the discussions held during last meeting on 29th Jan,2013 regarding settlement of Bills of Millers for KMS 2011-12 without requiring additional certification by district office regarding services provided by millers for Mandi handling, loading etc.

Clause 19.7 of the Operational Guidelines for KMS 2011-12 stipulates that *“The PACS, WSHG, PP and custom millers shall furnish certificate in the prescribed format (as at Annexure-III) to the District Manager for payment of Mandi labour charges.”* However the Form of Certificate for Mandi Handling Operation (Annexure-III) is *“To be furnished by PACS/WSHG/PP”* as is evident from the Form being printed at page-85 of the OSCSC Booklet for KMS 2011-12. As such, Annexure-III is not required to be submitted by the miller. **Moreover, the required certification regarding Mandi Handling operations and supply of once used gunny for packing and transportation of paddy by miller has already been incorporated on the face of the Paddy Acceptance Note itself and there may be no need for any additional certification.**

Similarly, Clause 19.6 stipulates for submission of certificate as per Annexure-II to be issued by the Purchase Officer of purchase centre run by OSCSC Ltd but **the requisite details and certification for the services done by the miller is already available on the A.C.Note duly signed by both the miller as well as the Purchase Officer.**

Your honour may kindly appreciated that there has been un-precedented delay in delivery of CMR due to space crunch and the millers have not been able to get reimbursement of huge amount of Milling, Transportation and Handling charges for a long period. Now they deserve your sympathetic consideration.

We therefore, most humbly suggest that suitable clarification may kindly be issued to District Managers for early settlement of bills of custom millers on the basis of the details mentioned in the Acceptance Notes without requiring any additional certification and oblige.
