I am directed to invite reference to your letter No.577 dt.19.12.2013 on the subject mentioned above and to say that in order to compensate the farmers for the loss due to twin disasters, Government of Odisha has been pleased to decide for payment of an amount of Rs.100/- as special calamity assistance per quintal upto a maximum of 100 quintals per farmer for sale of paddy to State Agencies upto 30th April 2014.

Some farmers are moving their paddy for sale in neighbouring districts for getting higher price than Minimum Support Price (MSP) due to huge demand in those States. The Co-operation Department have clarified that if there is any movement of paddy by farmers to outside States, the RMC shall not charge 2% market fees. Finance Department has also clarified to exempt 2% CST on paddy moved to outside States by the farmers and traders.
