Subject: Colour Coding of Gunny Bags to facilitate identification of crop year of stock for KMS 2014-2015.

Sir.

I am directed to refer to this Department's letter of even number dated 10th February, 2014 and to say that it has been decided to adopt RED Colour Coding for gunny bags for KMS 2014-15. The colour coding will be in the manner indicated below:

- 1. Colour coding or identification marking on every bag at a distance of about 150 mm away from any one side of the selvedge shall be in "RED" colour;
- 2. Stencii or Branding as per indentors' requirements shall be in "BLUE" colour;
- 3. Marking or Stitching on the mouth of the bag after filling the grain will be done by the FCI/State Agencies in "RED" colour;
- 4. A single BLUE stripe running along the length of the bag at the centre shall be kept unchanged.
- This letter supersedes the earlier letter of even number dated 10th February, 2014.
