**Regarding procurement of paddy (locally called Bora) from**  
**Athagarh sub-Division area**

Letter no-34 dated 04.01.13 of Collector, Cuttack

Sir,

In inviting a reference to your letter on the subject cited above, I am directed to say that, Govt. have been pleased to allow you to procure "Bora" variety of paddy from Athagarh sub-division area of Cuttack district under DCP during the KMS 2012-13 under the following terms & conditions.

1. "Bora" variety paddy may be procured in identified areas.
2. Such paddy is to be purchased at earmarked purchase centres on specified days.
3. Separate register is to be maintained by the concerned society or Purchase Officer.
4. Paddy to be milled at specified mills separately
5. Miller to maintain separate register & to store the paddy and rice separately.
6. As the percentage of reddishrice in the resultant rice will be more than 3% i.e. admissible limit as per the standard specification the resultant rice is to be treated as State Pool Procurement. It is only to be utilized for PDS locally as this cannot be given to FCI or to other district for distribution.
7. Rice to be received at specified RRC and to be kept separately in separate stocks.
8. District Manager, Cuttack may ascertain the feasibility of utilization of this rice under PDS. Test milling & actual use by consumer may be done on trial basis for making such assessment.
9. The rice to be distributed under PDS only in those areas from where that variety of paddy to be procured. For this, the requirement of PDS and procurement targets may be balanced.
10. After completing above formalities & putting in place the above system "Bora" rice may be procured under standard procedure of procurement.
